



Rink Maintenance Manager

Key Responsibilities

- Pre-season
 - Ensure rink surface is clear of anything that could damage the rink liner
 - Ensure rink boards are assembled and stable
 - Manage the rollout of the liner and final rink assembly
 - Manage the initial fill of the rink with water
 - Check that all rink equipment is in working order
- In-season
 - Ensure ice surface is clear of snow before each day of opening
 - Zamboni the ice to ensure a smooth surface before each day of opening
 - Mark unsafe areas and/or alert the Rink Manager if conditions warrant closing
 - Monitor rink ice surface to ensure safety of ice
 - Operate and maintain equipment
 - Ensure all water lines are properly maintained and heated to prevent freezing
- Post-season
 - Winterize any equipment as necessary
 - Drain the rink once fully melted
 - Disassemble rink and store boards inside
 - Cut and bag rink liner for trash pickup

Requirements

- 18 years of age or older
- Available to work seasonally on-demand (as snow falls), on nights, weekends and holidays
- Physically capable of performing manual labor
- Maintain a high level of communication with management and board members

Ideally you also

- Are detail oriented and civic-minded
- Have prior ice rink, facility, or grounds management experience

Hours and Compensation

- Hours vary by week for this part-time, seasonal position (December Holiday through March)
- Hourly compensation is based on qualifications around \$30/hour
